This guide provides quick installation instructions on how to install Radinium Reports for Milestone XProtect®. It lists all product requirements and guides you through the installation process. It also explains how to obtain a 30-day Trial License and to configure your server. This guide can be used by system integrators and administrators.

Installation Prerequisites

Milestone Express+, Professional+, Expert, Corporate 2019 R3 or higher must be installed and working. (Tested)

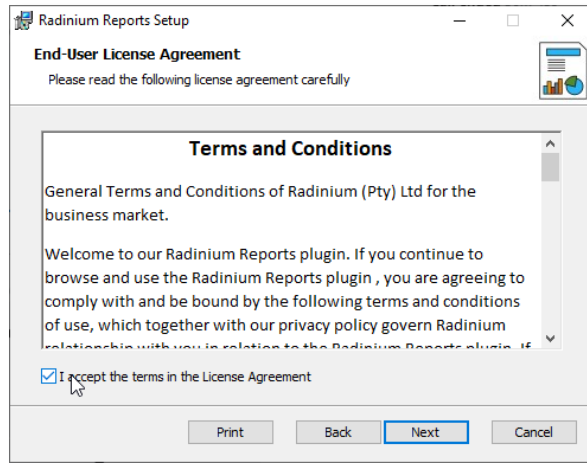
Installing Reports

1. Download Click from www.radinium.com.
2. Run the setup package 'Radinium_Reports_1.0.0.0.msi'.
3. Do you want to install Radinium Reports? Press Yes.
4. Installer will Extract.

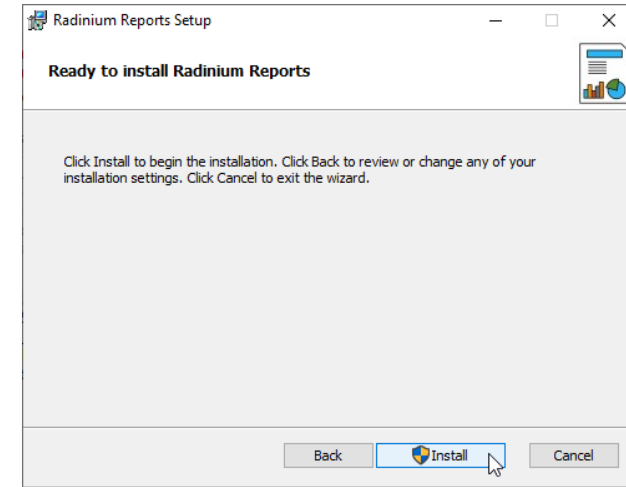


5. Press Next.

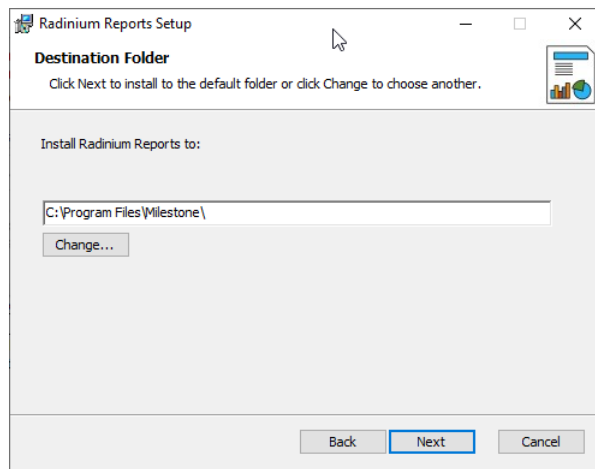
6. Accept the terms in the License Agreement and press Next.



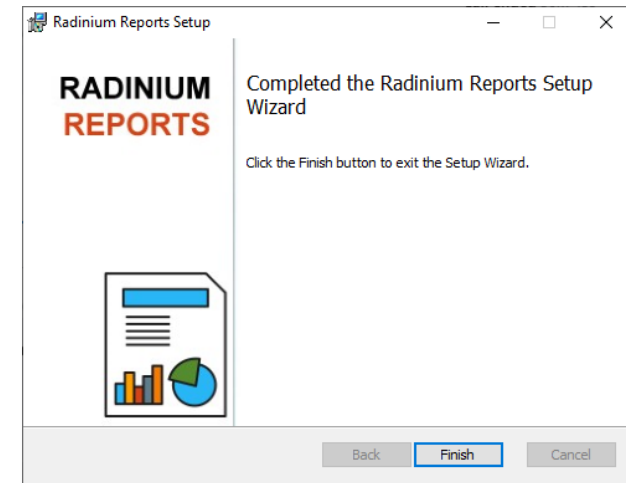
8. Press next to install.

9. Press Close when done.

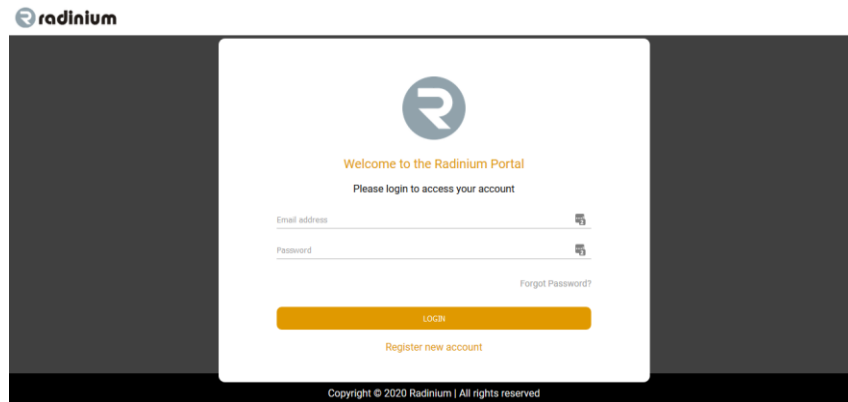


Obtaining a 30 day Trial License

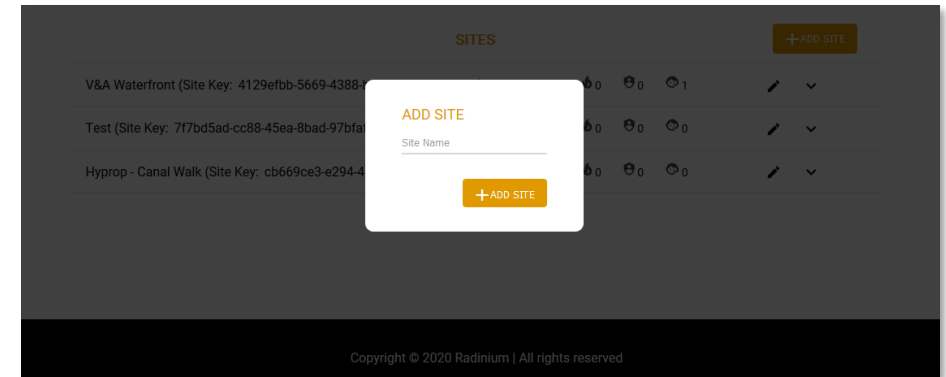
1. Go to www.radium.com.
2. Click on Portal on the top menu.



3. Register an account if you do not have your login credentials.



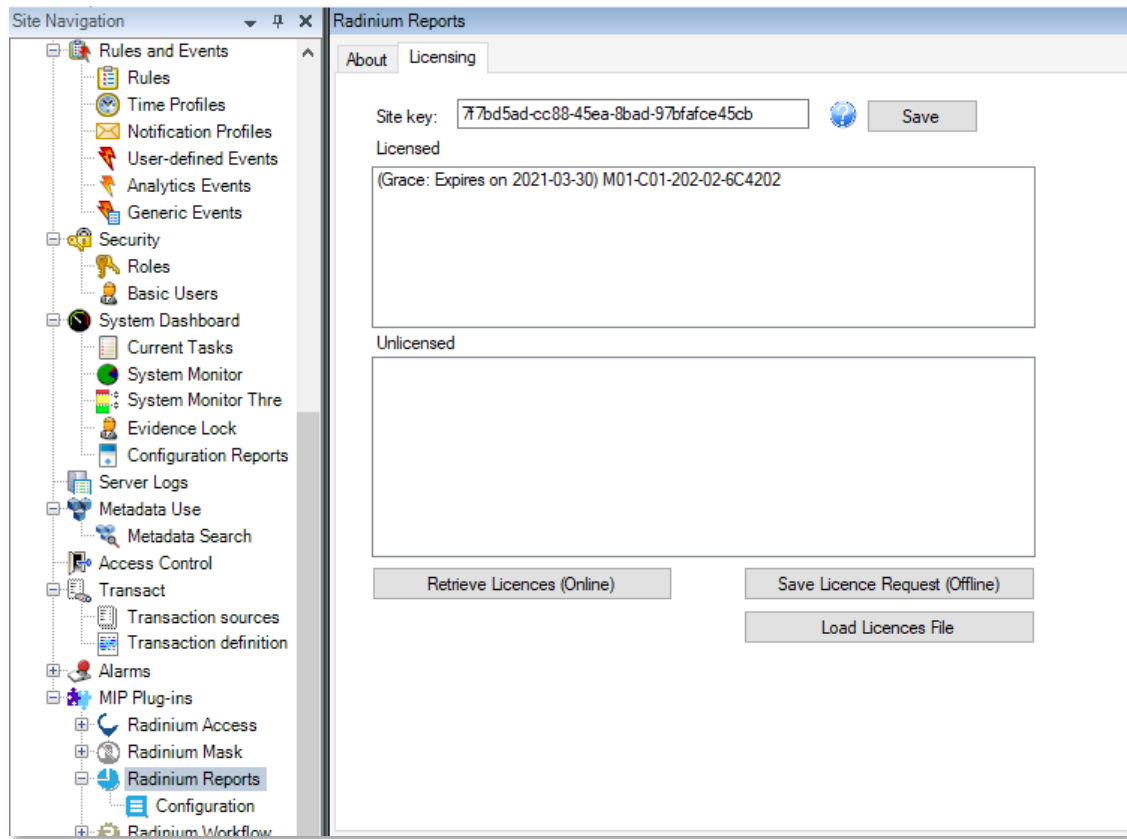
4. Once you are logged in, go to Add Site and enter your Site Name.



5. Copy your Site Key onto your clipboard by pressing the Copy icon or copy/select with your mouse.

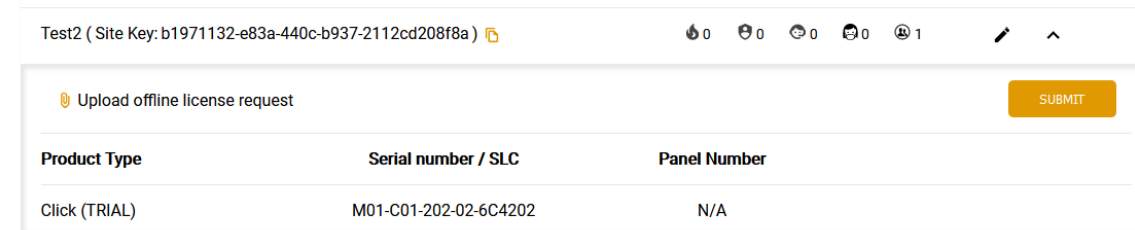

6. Open the Milestone Management Client and go to MIP Plug-ins, Radium Reports -> Licensing. Copy the Site Key inside the Site Key box and Save. You will then see an unlicensed key. Click Retrieve License (Online) if you are connected to the Internet. It will retrieve a License with a 30-day grace period linked with your Milestone SLC and Server ID.



If you do not have internet onsite, go to the Offline License Request section in this document

7. To check your Registered Trial License, go back to the Portal and click on the down arrow, which will show your Site License linked with your SLC.



Offline license request

Instead of retrieving your license online, you can Save License Request (Offline) in the Milestone Management Client in a .lrc file.

Take that file, go to your Portal and upload the Offline License Request. It will generate a .lic file, which you can then upload in the Management Client Radium Click Licensing tab by clicking on Load License File.

Server address: Type in the Management Server hostname or ip address.

Authentication type: Choose between Windows or Basic authentication.

Username & Password: Type in an authorized user which is able to log in to Milestone and retrieve logs from the log server.

Press 'Test Milestone connection' button to verify a successful connection.

Email settings:

From address: Type in email address that will be displayed when receiving the email.

To address: Type in email address where you want to send the report.

Subject: Type in the subject line of the email.

SMTP Host: Type in your SMTP Host mail address; an SMTP outgoing address. Get more details from your email service provider.

SMTP Port: Type in the SMTP Port number associated with the SMTP Security selected; SSL or Cleartext

SMTP Username & Password: Type in the SMTP login credentials.

All passwords are encrypted.

Press 'Save Configuration' button and press 'Send test email' to verify a successful email test. You will receive a test email on success.
